PROCEDURES WHEN USING POOL

1. Swimmers change into swimsuit in the locker room and put their clothes in lockers.
2. Swimmers are required to take a shower, rinse hair and advised to use the bathroom.
3. Swimmers and spectators **must remove footwear and walk through footbath** before entering the pool area.
4. If swimmer has had any gastrointestinal issues, they should not swim for two weeks after the issue has subsided.
5. The lifeguard must enter the pool area first, and unlock pool doors.
6. When swimmers enter the pool area, they must sit quietly on the bleachers until permission and/or instructions are given to enter the water.
7. Children should be paired into buddies.
8. A parent must accompany any child under five years old into the pool.
9. Children will be asked to take a deep water test prior to entering into the deep end. This test will be given by the lifeguard.
10. The lifeguard is the last person to leave the pool area whereupon he/she locks the pool door.
11. No glass containers or bottles may be brought or used in the locker rooms or pool area .
