Course Descriptions

- **Advanced Nature Detectives (3-5)** - We will further deepen understandings of the concepts & vocabulary used when discussing our environment. We will go into more detail about various climates and the roles of animals in their habitats.
- **Art Adventures (K-5)** - Join in the fun as we make fantastic projects such as carousel horses and custom made books. We will use different media as we create, draw, paint, sculpt, cut and glue. Different projects are done each semester.
- **Ballet (K-5)** - Based on the discipline of classical ballet, students will be engaged in learning established, and experimenting with creative movements that align with varying rhythms and styles of music.
- **Beginner Spanish (1-5)** - This class will teach students the basics of Spanish. The students will become comfortable learning the new language by starting with the alphabet, greetings, numbers, nouns, etc. No prior experience needed.
- **Beginner Tennis at Hardscrabble Club (1-5)** - Red Ball Tennis starting level of tennis for 10&U kids. Includes transport from PQ to Hardscrabble Club. Parent/guardian pick up @ Hardscrabble Club at 4:30 PM.
- **Brick Kids (LEGO) (K-5)** - Time Travel: We will build the Great Wall of China, the pyramids of Egypt, a Wild West town, a future city, and more; all with LEGOtm bricks! Join us and build history!
- **Chess (K-5)** - Students will learn how to play the fun and exciting game of chess. Students will work in small groups based on age and ability for structured lessons on chess strategy and supervised play.
- **Cooking 1 & 2 (3-5); Cooking 3 (4-5)** - Join Chef Debra Rizzo, Culinary Institute of America Graduate, for these fun, interactive 1 hour hands on workshops. Prior levels are prerequisite. Students with dietary restrictions and/or allergies are strongly cautioned. For more information please email chefrizzo@hotmail.com before enrolling.
- **Clay (K-5)** - Students will create a variety of clay sculptures using pinch pots, slabs and coils. Then the students will glaze each sculpture. At the final session, students take all their projects home.
- **Computer Kids (1-3)** - Computer Professional Debbie Putillo will teach your child basic components and terminology of a computer, how to use a word processor, how to search the internet, and how to use a basic image editing program.
- **Crafting Club (K-2; 3-5)** - This is a club for students who like to show their crafty side through seasonal decorations and unique room decor.
- **Creative Fairies (2-5)** - Students will create a fairy to go on fun-filled STEAM adventures such as riding a zipline to safety or saving an LED origami pet. They will work with Squishy circuits and learn about problem solving & teamwork.
- **Cultural Dances (K-5)** - An international tour of folk dances and cultural dance expressions from various countries including Europe, Asia, The Middle East, Africa and South America.
- **Cursive for Kids (2-5)** - Cursive is an art form that helps to develop the right-side of the brain, and also develops fine motor skills. By the end of the course, students will be able to write & read the cursive alphabet.
- **Dance Fit (K-5)** - Kids will use lots of energy trying out different dance styles while learning to love movement. They'll pick up basic steps, grooving to some of their favorite songs, as well as music from all over the world.
- **Drawing (1-5)** - Our elementary-age curriculum is designed to teach basic to advanced drawing skills, art techniques and vocabulary. You'll see increased art abilities, learning skills, self-confidence and self-esteem.
- **Guitar Club (1-3; 4-5)** - Learn how to play guitar in a fun setting with Music Cottage instructor Joe Krzyzewski. Bring your own guitar or rent one from the Music Cottage. No experience necessary.
- **Hip Hop Dance (K-4)** - Class has a high energy upbeat choreography. Dancers will learn a combination to show their families for end of the semester. All music and choreography is age appropriate. A fun introduction to dance!!!
- **Ice Skating** - Learn to Ice Skate at the Brewster Ice Arena with the North Salem Rec Dept. This program is for skaters with varying levels of skating experience. Fee includes public skate before lesson. Skate rental is not included.
- **Junior Nature Detectives (K-2)** - Learn all about our animal world, what they do and how they do it. Our unique hands-on presentations include live animals and nature materials. Taught by naturalists from The Nature of Things.
- **Musical Theater by Barbara Rue (4-5)** - Theatre games, basic dance movements, diction, & acting exercises will help build understanding of what preparing for a character in a show is about. Exploring theatre is fun and exciting for kids.
- **Musical Theater by Spotlight Arts (1-5)** - Learn basic theatre skills (memorization, characterization, technique and confidence) as they relate to musical theatre. Learn script and score, memorize and perform selected songs & dances.
- **PQ Post (3-5)** - Students have the opportunity to express themselves through creative writing, poetry, illustrations, opinion/ review articles, puzzles, interviews, and other fun stuff! Paper is published a few times per school year.
- **Robotics (3-5)** - Students will work with Dash and Dot, Spero or Vex IQ writing and debugging algorithms while programming robots for challenges. If interested in coding only, students will work with Hour of Code and Scratch 3.0.
- **Sewing: Llama Drama** - Inspired by the art and culture of South America. Students will begin by practicing stitches on a round mug rug, then will have fun creating a llama stuffie and blanket, and will finally create a llama keychain.
- **Soccer Kickers (K-3)** - Coach Debbie Putillo will teach your child the basic fundamentals of soccer including dribbling, passing, and shooting. Rules of the game will be taught while your child engages in small sided games and skill exercises.
- **STEM (2-5)** - Science, Technology, Engineering & Math. Course topics range from coding and robotics to 3D printing,
- **TGA Tennis (K-5)** - We get students moving while teaching them the fundamentals of the game. Station-based games and drills increase in difficulty as players progress through our 5-level enrichment program. Come play with TGA!
- **TGA Golf (K-5)** - Station-based drills and games develop the fundamental skills of grip, forehand, backhand, volley, and serve. Students explore concepts like gravity, force, and spin.
- **Wild for Wolves (2-3; 4-5)** - Take a walk on the wild side at the Wolf Conservation Center (WCC) as we give your young animal lover a chance to thrive among wolves! 4-5 PM at the WCC in South Salem - own transport required.
- **Yoga (K-2; 3-5)** - Inspire and empower through yoga. Class will improve strength, flexibility, coordination, & respect for self and others. Instructor is local resident, PQ mom and certified yoga instructor Bryn Page Northshield.
