Dear Parents,

Your child is registered to take one or more Advanced Placement Examinations; the schedule and locations for the exams are attached.

Completion of the Advanced Placement Examination is a requirement of the Advanced Placement course in which your child is enrolled. In the event that a student elects not to take the exam, the Advanced Placement designation on the college transcript will be removed and colleges and universities will be informed of the change. The CollegeBoard states that if a student has a "serious illness or injury, or if there is a family tragedy a student would be eligible for late testing". A doctor's note to excuse the absence would be required.

Students are expected to attend all classes on the day of the AP exam. However, if a parent wishes to excuse a student from school prior to or following the completion of a test, a note will be required. As is our usual procedure, no student will be excused without a note.

The Advanced Placement Examination does not signal the completion of the school year. Attendance, participation, and completion of assignments are required for successful completion of the course. Classes will be held by teachers and students are required to attend.
