This year the Westchester/Putnam Science and Engineering Fair (WESEF) has nearly 700 high school students presenting their research projects. While the increase in participation is a wonderful thing, we desperately need your help as we still do not have enough judges to accommodate the number of students.

Please consider volunteering as a science fair judge at WESEF on Saturday, March 16th and/or passing along the attached flier to other qualified people that may be willing to volunteer as well.

When: Saturday March 16th, 2019 9:00am – 2:30pm (though you can register for part of the day if you are not able to stay for the full time)

Where: Sleepy Hollow High School, Sleepy Hollow, NY - 210 North Broadway (Route 9)

What: Evaluate student poster presentations in symposium style, one on one, interactions while encouraging these bright and talented high school scientists to be passionate about science. Judge rubric and information sheet with FAQ's are attached for you to preview.

Judging Requirements:

Have a minimum of 2 years related professional experience beyond receiving their B.A., B.S., or Master's degree. This would include school psychologists, social workers, registered nurses, EPA and DEA professionals.

OR

Have a Ph.D., M.D., or equivalent (D.O., Ed.D., D.D.S., D.V.M., etc.),

OR

Is a current graduate student with more than 2 years of doctoral-level research experience or who is within one year of doctoral dissertation defense.
